APPLICATION PACKET CHECKLIST:

1. **Essay:** Applicants must attach an essay not to exceed 750 words. The essay should:
 - outline educational and career goals and strategies to assure success of goals
 - include information about work experience, volunteerism, mentorship, or internships – especially any related to career goals or college field of study
 - include information about community involvement
 - include information about extracurricular activities
 - describe leadership skills developed because of these activities
 - indicate why this financial support is important
 - indicate if you are a first-generation college student
 - be persuasive and well written using good mechanics
2. **Resume:** Applicants must include a quality resume including work experience, volunteer work within the community, leadership experience, and extracurricular activities.
3. **2 Letters of recommendation:** Two letters of recommendation are required, **BOTH from NON-family** members who can attest to career goals, character, and leadership potential.
4. **Transcript:** Must include an unofficial copy.

Scholarship Details (this page does not need to be included in the packet)

To be considered for this scholarship all of the following must be completed:

- Students must have a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average.
- The selection committee will give priority to students based on their level of involvement in college related field of study or related career goals.
- All materials (applicant information and checklist page, essay, copy of transcript, resume and 2 letters of recommendation) must be included for applicant to be considered for a scholarship.
- Application materials must be to the Coeur d'Alene Regional Chamber by the scholarship deadline March 17, 2023 to be considered.

Scholarship Recipients:

- Will be invited and expected to attend the Coeur d'Alene Regional Chamber Upbeat Breakfast at the Coeur d'Alene Resort on April 11, 2023, to receive their award.
- \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors from area private or public high schools that are CDA Regional Chamber members, as well as any senior of a CDA Regional Chamber member regardless of city of residence.
- The scholarships will be available to students attending any post-secondary approved/accredited school within the United States of America.
