APPLICATION PACKET CHECKLIST:

1. **Thoughtful Answers:** Applicants must attach five short answers, not to exceed 150 words per question. The questions are:
  - Outline your educational and career aspirations and explain how receiving this scholarship will support you in reaching these goals.
  - How have you contributed to your community through volunteer work, supporting local initiatives, or making an impact through your employment responsibilities?
  - What leadership qualities do you admire most, and who in your life has exemplified these traits? In what ways have you demonstrated or modeled these leadership qualities in your own experiences?
  - Share a challenge you've faced and how you overcame it, or describe an experience that has significantly shaped and strengthened your character.
  - How have your work, volunteer efforts, or extracurricular activities shaped and influenced your educational and career aspirations?
2. **Resume:** Applicants must include a quality resume including work experience, volunteer work within the community, leadership experience, and extracurricular activities. If needed, this link will help you. <https://resumegenius.com/resume-builder/app/how-to-start>
3. **2 Letters of recommendation:** Two letters of recommendation are required, **BOTH from NON-family** members who can attest to career goals, career goals, strength of character, and leadership potential.
4. **Transcript:** Must include an unofficial copy showing 7 semesters of grades.

**To be considered for this scholarship all the following must be completed:**

- Students must have a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average.
- The selection committee will give priority to students based on their level of involvement in college related field of study or related career goals.
- First-generation status and financial need may be taken into account as part of the selection process.
- All materials (applicant information and checklist page, essay, copy of transcript, resume and two letters of recommendation) must be included for applicant to be considered for a scholarship.
- Application materials must be submitted online or delivered to the Coeur d'Alene Regional Chamber by the scholarship deadline March 7, 2025, 5:00 PM, to be considered.

### **Scholarship Recipients:**

- Will be invited and expected to attend the Coeur d'Alene Regional Chamber Upbeat Breakfast at the Coeur d'Alene Resort on April 22, 2025, to receive their award.
- \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors from area private or public high schools that are CDA Regional Chamber members, as well as any senior of a CDA Regional Chamber member regardless of city of residence.
- The scholarships will be available to students attending any post-secondary approved/accredited school within the United States of America.
